

BARBECUE USE

Welcome to the Maurie Kjar swimming pool barbecue facility. Please note the following:

- \$5 for two hours use payable prior to using BBQ. No telephone bookings can be accepted. Please bring your receipt with you on the day of your function as it must be sighted by the lifeguard before you use the BBQ.
- For refunds, cancellations or postponement – if, for any reason, you cannot keep your booking please advise Council staff (306 9009) as soon as possible during office hours; after hours contact pool staff (323 6109).
- Monday to Friday – first BBQ booking 10.00am – last BBQ at 3.30pm (must be finished cooking and BBQ cleaned by 4.30pm).
- Saturday and Sunday – first BBQ booking 12.00pm – last BBQ at 5.30pm (must be finished cooking and BBQ cleaned by 6.30pm).
- Please use cooking oil, **NOT** fat or dripping.
- Please note that the seating and BBQ is to be shared with other members of the public. Please ensure that the kitchen and BBQ are clean and ready for the next BBQ user.
- There are two power points available at the BBQ bench.
- Permission is required to bring bouncy castles etc in through the emergency gates. A fee of \$20 is payable for the use of the grassed area within the complex and is treated as a private hire.
- No alcohol is permitted at the pool during public hours.
- BBQ area is smoke free.
- There is no fridge/freezer available.

Active Supervision of Children

Pool Safe and Council's policy is that a caregiver over the age of 16 years must actively supervise children under 8 years of age at all times.

A caregiver must:

- Be in the same pool within reach of the child/children or at pool side.
- This excludes the spa pool; an adult must be in the spa with child/children 7 years and under.
- **Do not leave a child/children unattended**

Should a caregiver fail to adequately supervise child/children, at our pool, staff may request that the child/children get(s) out of the water.
