

Mountain View Rest Home and Retirement Village

Mountain View is a community owned aged care complex which offers full time hospital and rest home care for 42 residents as well as respite and day care, meals, coordinated activities and social interaction for the elderly in our community. There is also a 15 cottage independent living, retirement village. These are held under a "License to Occupy" tenure. In 2000 the Kawerau District Council assigned management of the town's pensioner housing comprising 27 rental flats to Mountain View. The units, situated in Waterhouse Street and Porritt Drive are in close proximity to the rest home.

When the last baby was born at the Maternity Hospital in March 1987, it was agreed by local residents and the then Hospital Board that the purchase of the building and its transformation to a rest home would proceed.



Work started in late 1989 and hours of work by volunteers ensued and in March 1991 the building was ready for its first resident.

Over the years a progression of building expansions have been undertaken to create the present day Mountain View Aged Care Complex, of retirement village, rest home and hospital facility, which is a great asset for the town of Kawerau.
