Some months ago, Dog Ranger Rex McLeod of Kawerau was brutally attacked while on the job. His story was televised on 3 News, TV One and in NZ Herald and local papers. It was agreed that the Kawerau community, with support from RNZFB, Kawerau District Council and the “Te Rex Kawerau Guide Dog Puppy Appeal” would aim to raise \$22,500 for a new guide dog puppy to be named “Rex” after retired local dog ranger, Rex McLeod.

Currently, there are around 240 blind or partially sighted New Zealanders whose guide dogs give them confidence, companionship and greater independence.
