

Kawerau District Council Community Grant Scheme

The Kawerau District Council would like to invite applications
for the final round of the Community Grants Scheme for the 2011/12 year

So what is a Community Grant Scheme?

The Community Grant Scheme is a fund provided by the Kawerau District Council, made available to community groups, organisations and/or services within the Kawerau District who through their services help enhance the lives and well-being of Kawerau residents by fulfilling a community need.

How much is allocated to the Community Grant Scheme?

Each year Council allocates \$19,310 per year to this fund and successful applicants who are eligible to apply can receive a grant of up to \$3,000.

Who is eligible to apply?

Any non profit organisation which has the ability to deliver services that have a significant benefit to the people or even animals within our community may apply.

Who may not be eligible to apply?

Projects which would not be eligible to apply for this fund include:

- Groups that have already received Council funding from the Community Grant Scheme this current financial year;

- Arts or cultural events as these types of events are covered under the Creative Communities Scheme;
- Events that would normally be covered under our Events Management Fund;
- Services that would normally be covered by funding from Central Government;
- Recipients who have not supplied an accountability record for previous funding.

So how do I apply?

All applications for funding must be submitted in writing.
