

KENNEL LICENCE APPLICATION TO KEEP THREE DOGS

A licence is not required for one or two dogs.

NO FEE is required for this licence. However, to keep three dogs on your property, a licence must be applied for.

No person shall keep, or cause to be kept, or have in his/her care three dogs of a greater age than three months unless a kennel licence has been obtained from the Council permitting three dogs to be kept.

Wish to make application for a Licence to Keep Three Dogs in accordance with the Dog Control Bylaw 2019

Kawerau District Council Dog Control Bylaw 2019

Any dog owner is allowed to keep up to two (2) dogs on the premises.

Any dog owner who has a kennel licence from Council is allowed to keep three (3) dogs on the premises.

Dog owners must obtain special approval from Council to keep four (4) or more dogs on the premises. In determining whether to grant approval, Council will consider the following:

- a. The location of the property;
- b. The size of the property;
- c. The views of the immediate neighbours; and
- d. Any previous complaints about the owner or the additional dog(s);
- e. Any other factors it considers relevant.

Council may impose any reasonable conditions on the special approval.

I agree to abide by the following conditions:-

CONDITIONS RELATING TO THE ISSUE OF LICENCE

1. The number of dogs on the premises shall NOT exceed the number permitted as indicated on the licence.
2. All dogs kept on the premises must be housed in such a manner as not to cause a nuisance to neighbours or any person.
3. Kennels, runs and other areas on the property used by the dogs must be kept clean and free from nuisance conditions.
4. All requirements of the Kawerau District Council Dog Control Bylaw and the Dog Control Act 1996 and subsequent amendments must be met.
5. All deaths, sales or transfers of dogs, (including pups born on the premises) are to be notified to Council within 14 days.
6. A licence may be subject to such terms, conditions and restrictions as Council may from time to time consider necessary to impose.
7. A licence may be revoked if there is any breach of its conditions.

NOTE: Any person wishing to keep more than Three Dogs requires Special Council Approval.
