



Kerbside Rubbish Collection in Kawerau

Recycling crates and the general waste bins (60 litre or 120 litre) are collected weekly. The large 240 litre Greenwaste is collected every fortnight on the same day as your recycling and general waste.



What and How to Recycle

Glass



- Glass bottles and jars only (all colours)
- Please rinse all bottles and jars
- Place in your crate
- NO broken glass or any other types of glass
- Broken glass and light bulbs go into general waste bin



- Grade 1,2 and 5 only e.g. milk and cream bottles, water bottles and yoghurt containers. All other plastic goes into your residual waste bin
- Please remove caps, wash and squash
- 1, 2 and 5 Place in your crate



- Please rinse all food cans
- Remove the lids and place inside of



All grades of paper and cardboard
Please flatten all cardboard and tie together if needed to reduce flying away

Remove the lids and place inside of cans (flatten preferred- no need to remove labels)
Place in your crate

• Place beneath your bin if oversize

80 kg weight limit

The 240 litre Greenwaste bin can be used to dispose of:



- Lawn clippings
- Weeds
- Leaves (no flax)
- Old plants
- Soft prunings



DO NOT load with **soil/concrete/bricks** or put any food waste contaminants in your bin.
