Congratulations

to those elected to the Kawerau District Council

Kawerau district finished with a 45.3% voter turnout. Congratulations to Mayor-elect Faylene Karen Ngareta Tunui who has been elected Mayor of Kawerau. Congratulations to new Councillors-elect Tracy Hill, Anthony Ross Worsley, Waikite Apiata, Mal Dowie and Gloria Te Paki Leokava-Taani, and returning councillors Berice Joyce Julian, Sela Kingi and Justin Ross.

The poll to keep or remove Māori wards for the Kawerau district resulted in a large majority in favour of keeping Māori wards. 1,557 voters voted to keep and 710 voted to remove Māori Wards. This means that Māori wards will be in place this term 2025 to 2028, and again in 2028 to 2031, and 2031 to 2034. Council will be required to undertake another representation review after the 2031 election, for the 2034 election.

Thank you to everyone who exercised their right to vote, and a big thank you to all the candidates who stood up for their community.
